ENTERING COMPETITIONS

Entering online showday.online/show/myrtleford

1. Create a new account or login to your account using your previous details from last year's show entries or any other show that uses Show Day Online
2. Select the Myrtleford Show
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account
6. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional
7. In EXHIBIT TYPE select
 - HORSES & CATTLE for Horses & Cattle
 - FARM ANIMAL for Other Animals
 - PAVILION / INDOOR / DISPLAY for all Other Sections
8. Click on SELECT CLASSES
9. From the drop down choose what you would like to enter
10. On the pop up tick the box to accept the entry notes for this section
11. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes
12. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them
13. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter
14. Fill out the item's name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable e.g. painting name and any other fields as asked
15. ONCE ALL CLASSES HAVE BEEN SELECTED
16. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process.
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show.
18. On the next screen select do not select any 'extra items'. These are not relevant to The Myrtleford Show competitions.
19. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done.
20. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's
21. Click on the payment type and enter any payment details as required
22. Click on PAY NOW and follow the payment options.
23. You will now be emailed an acknowledgement of your entries. Please check you Junk / Spam folder if this email is not in your inbox.

Spring Show Horse Jackpot Competition 2026

Attend as many participating Agricultural Shows as possible and earn points throughout the season. Points will be awarded in the first ridden ring of the day for 1st & 2nd Place plus Champion & Reserve Champion.

There are two separate Jackpot competitions:

- Open Ridden - Show Pony, Show Galloway, Show Hack
- Show Hunter Ridden - Show Hunter Pony, Show Hunter Galloway, Show Hunter Hack

Participating Shows are Albury, Benalla, Berrigan, Cobram, Corowa, Finley, Myrtleford, Nathalia, Rutherglen, Wangaratta, Yarrawonga.

Prize packages will be awarded to the winner and runner-Up in both sections from a cash prize pool of \$1,650, donated by the shows, and donations from MultiCube and Woodlock photography.

Regulations:

General

- Entry and waiver required for all exhibitors; parent/guardian signature required for competitors under 18.
- The committee may cancel or alter classes, divide classes, or refuse entries.
- No refunds without a medical or vet certificate.
- All persons attending the Show must pay gate entry. If competitors gate entry is not purchased with entries, gate admission must be paid on the day.

Safety & Conduct

- All horses and riders compete at their own risk. The Myrtleford & District A&P Society accepts no liability.
- The committee may remove any animal considered unsafe, diseased, or unfit.
- Random drug testing may occur.
- Inappropriate behaviour/bullying will be reported to VAS Ltd.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for children at all times.

Entries & Competition Rules

- Classes run at the judge's discretion.
- Exhibitor age is as at Show Day.
- A novice is a horse/pony that has not won a first prize at an agricultural show.
- Competitors must enter as either Show Horse or Show Hunter (not both) and remain in that category for the calendar year (VAS rule).

Breed & Registration

- Breed classes require horses/ponies to be registered with, and owners to be members of, a relevant breed society.
- Miniature, Small/Little Ponies, Coloured and Heavy Horses must be registered or eligible for registration.
- Mountain & Moorland eligible breeds: Exmoor, Dartmoor, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Fell, Dales.
- Breeding age is calculated as at 1 August each year.

Rider & Equipment Requirements

- Approved helmets meeting Australian standards must be worn at all times when riding (harness secured).
- Pony Club uniform is permitted.

Handling & Assistance

- Stallions must be handled/ridden by competitors 18+
- Exception: Ridden stallions under 12.2 hh in Ring 2 with written parental consent
- In led classes, children under 13 or people with a disability may be assisted (judge's discretion)

Administration & Disputes

- Disputes must be lodged at the Secretary's Office with a \$100 deposit (refundable if upheld).
- By entering, exhibitors consent to photography for promotional use.

Additional Information

- Fun Ring entries available after Breed classes in Ring 2.
- Camping available Friday 23 October: \$20 per person (pay at Secretary's Office).

VAS Qualifier Regulations

Myrtleford Show is affiliated with the Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd (VAS Ltd) and may conduct qualifying events for the VAS Saddle Horse Championships, Good Hands Challenge Trophy, Racing Victoria Off The Track Series and Alabar Hero Series.

Saddle Horse Championships

Qualification Period

- 1 January 2026 to 14 December 2026

Championship Qualification Requirements

- Open Classes
 - 1 Champion, or
 - 2 Reserve Champions, or
 - 2 First Places at VAS-affiliated shows.
- Rider Classes
 - 1 First Place, or
 - 2 Second Places at VAS-affiliated shows.

VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy

Open to riders 10 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the qualifying show.

Conditions

- The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account.
- Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony.
- Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband.
- Please note straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.
- A gear check may take place.

The winner qualifies for the VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy State Final.

Racing Victoria Off The Track Series

Ridden & Led Open & Show Hunter Series

Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been stud book registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally. Registrations will be checked by VAS office.

- Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, please provide the following details (if known)
 - Racing name, Microchip number, Aust ID, Dam and Sire & Date horse retired
- Riders to be 12 years and over on day of qualifying Show in ridden classes.
- Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
- Qualifying classes will be judged ridden for ridden classes and led for led classes.
- Once a horse has won a ridden or led qualifier, the horse cannot compete at another show qualifier of the same qualifier type during that calendar year.
- All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Racing Victoria's Off The Track Ridden or Led Open or Show Hunter Series State Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
- To be judged as a good example of an Off the Track Thoroughbred, (rather than riding horse/hunter types), with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities, Conformation, Manners, paces and performance, Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judge's decision is Final.
- Show Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50.00 Prizemoney sent out once qualification has been verified by Racing Victoria (Prize pack collected at State Final)

Alabar Hero Series

Open to all purebred freeze branded or microchipped Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.

- Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number or microchip number must be provided.
- Horse does not need to be registered with any other Association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
- Riders to be aged 12 years and over on the day of the qualifying Show.
- Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
- Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
- Once a horse has won a qualifier, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
- All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar Hero Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
- To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities, Conformation, Manners, paces and performance, Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- The Judge's Decision is Final.
- Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50.00 Prizemoney sent out once qualification has been verified and Hero Gift Pack (Prize Pack collected at State Final).

Regulations

- This ring is intended for beginner, novice and intermediate handlers and riders who are new to showing or do not usually compete in show events.
- Open to:
 - Competitors under 18 years of age, and
 - Adults (18 years and over) with a disability.
- Beginner: Has not previously won a ribbon at an agricultural show.
- Novice: Has not previously won a first place at an agricultural show.
- Intermediate: Has not previously won a first place at a Royal Show.
- Placings will be awarded through to 6th place. Results will not be recorded.
- Stallions, colts and rigs are not permitted.
- Handlers and riders may have an assistant and/or be led. Assistants must be at least 14 years of age.
- If required, the assistant may either:
 - Hold the end of the lead, or
 - Use a second lead attached to the horse or pony on the same side as the handler.
- Horses and ponies are not required to be plaited but should be clean and neatly presented.
- Glitter, sparkles and temporary hair colour are permitted.
- Formal show attire is not required; however, approved helmets and suitable riding boots must be worn.
- Competitors may enter other rings. This ring is intended to be fun and supportive. The Judge or Steward may ask any competitor or assistant displaying overly competitive behaviour to leave the ring.
- The program may be altered on the day subject to entry numbers.

This ring is designed to provide a welcoming, supportive and inclusive showing experience for new and developing competitors.

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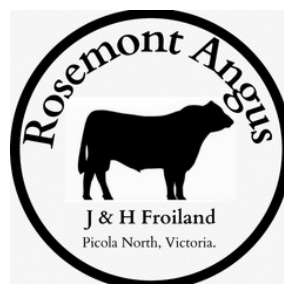
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
