- Exhibitors must complete an entry form and sign waiver – for anyone under 18 years on day of show
- No event will be held for exhibitors competing in another ring.
- If you win a championship in one ring, please do not compete in the same event on the same horse in the second ring.
- HACKS, GALLOWS OR PONIES MAY ONLY COMPETE IN SHOW HUNTER CLASSES OR OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES, NOT BOTH.
- A “First Season” hack, Galloway or pony is not to have competed under saddle prior to the 1st January 2018
- Stallions must be exhibited in led & ridden classes by person’s 18 years & over.
Exceptions: Ridden Shetland & Welsh Mountain Stallions with written parental consent.
- Pony Club uniform is acceptable for all events at this show.
- Exhibitor’s age is taken as on the day of this show.
- Smartest on Parade events. Ribbons to 6th place.
- A novice horse or pony has not won a first prize at an agricultural show.
- Local exhibitors must reside in the Alpine Shire or within a 30km radius of Myrtleford.
- All riders must wear protective headgear to the current Australian standard. The retaining harness must be secured & fastened at all times. Riders without approved headgear shall be ineligible to compete until rectified. This rule applies to all events, not just age competitions.
- GOOD HANDS: Competitors must compete in a plain snaffle bridle, no Hanoverian or dropped nosebands, no whips or spurs. Riders to be 10 to 14 years on day of show. The winner is eligible to compete in the final at the VAS Ltd Saddlehorse Championships in January 2018
- Off The Track and Alabar Hero classes will be judged approximately 12.30pm. Classes in rings 1 & 2 will cease whilst this is judged by judges from rings 1 & 2.

5. A combination must have attended two mounted rallies at their club in the preceding 12 months.
6. Gear check is compulsory for the pony club ring.
7. Medical armbands must be worn by competitors.
8. Pony club riders to wear full pony club uniform. Jodhpurs/breeches of banana, cream beige, white or fawn, boots and sleeved garment.
9. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCA Helmet standard.
10. Snaffle bits ONLY
11. Queries, protests, horse abuse rules apply as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
12. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
13. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
14. More than one horse may be ridden subject to the condition of PCV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules.

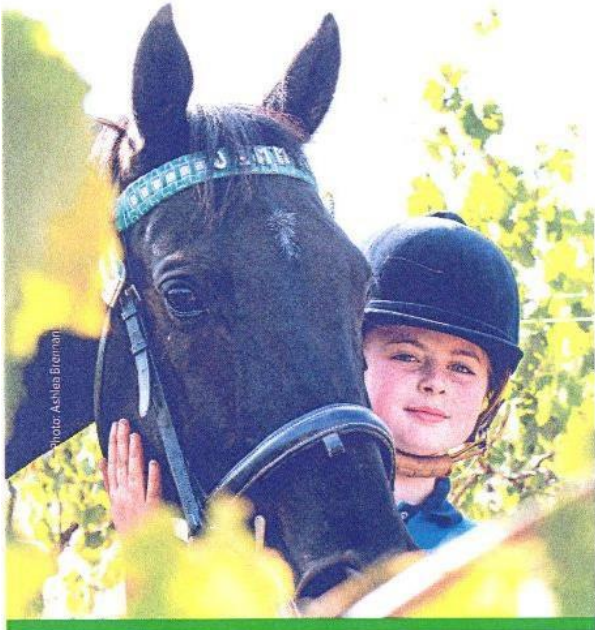

HERO SERIES FINAL REGULATIONS

1. To have qualified at a Qualifying Show in a HERO Series Class
2. Horse to be entered under Registered/Racing name where available.
3. Expected to walk, trot and canter with change of rein.
4. Judge may ride horses in final.
5. If judge does not ride exhibits, competitors will be asked to do an individual workout and show walk, trot and canter on both reins, finishing with a halt and salute to the judge/s.
6. Other regulations for the Final:-
 - In the event of one rider going through to the Final with more than one horse, they must nominate a substitute rider.
 - An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her employer.
 - An exhibitor may not show a horse judged by any member of his/her immediate family.
 - An exhibitor may not show under a judge that they have produced an equine for within the past 24 months.
