- Exhibitors must complete an entry form and sign waiver – for anyone under 18 years on day of show
- No event will be held for exhibitors competing in another ring.
- If you win a championship in one ring, please do not compete in the same event on the same horse in the second ring.
- HACKS, GALLOWS OR PONIES MAY ONLY COMPETE IN SHOW HUNTER CLASSES OR OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES, NOT BOTH.
- A “First Season” hack, Galloway or pony is not to have competed under saddle prior to the 1st January 2019
- Stallions must be exhibited in led & ridden classes by person’s 18 years & over. Exceptions: Ridden Shetland & Welsh Mountain Stallions with written parental consent.
- Pony Club uniform is acceptable for all events at this show.
- Exhibitor’s age is taken as on the day of this show.
- Smartest on Parade events. Ribbons to 6th place.
- A novice horse or pony has not won a first prize at an agricultural show.
- Local exhibitors must reside in the Alpine Shire or within a 50km radius of Myrtleford.
- All riders must wear protective headgear to the current Australian standard. The retaining harness must be secured & fastened at all times. Riders without approved headgear shall be ineligible to compete until rectified. This rule applies to all events, not just age competitions.
- GOOD HANDS: Competitors must compete in a plain snaffle bridle, no Hanoverian or dropped nosebands, no whips or spurs. Riders to be 10 to 14 years on day of show. The winner is eligible to compete in the final at the VAS Ltd Saddlehorse Championships in January 2019
- Off The Track and Alabar Hero classes will be judged approximately 12.30pm. Classes in rings 1 & 2 will cease whilst this is judged by judges from rings 1 & 2.

4. Pony club cards must be inspected before event
5. A combination must have attended two mounted rallies at their club in the preceding 12 months
6. Gear check is compulsory for the pony club ring.
7. Medical armbands are optional, but strongly encouraged.
8. Pony club riders to wear full pony club uniform. Jodhpurs/breeches of banana, cream beige, white or fawn, boots & sleeved garment.
9. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCA Helmet standard.
10. Snaffle bits ONLY
11. Queries, protest, horse abuse rules apply as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws
12. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
13. PCV Alcohol Policy applies
14. More than one horse may be ridden subject to the condition of PCV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules.
15. All exhibitors must complete entry form & sign waiver. Persons under 18yrs old must have a parent/guardian sign this form.

1. **Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.**
2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided.
3. Horse or Exhibitor do not need to be registered with any other Association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
4. Riders to be aged 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show.
5. Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
6. Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated.
7. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
8. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
9. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar HERO Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
10. To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Standardbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Racing related injuries and/or blemishes are permitted
11. The Judge's Decision is Final in the Qualifiers and Final.
12. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 Prize Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified and HERO Gift Pack (Gift Pack collected at State Final).

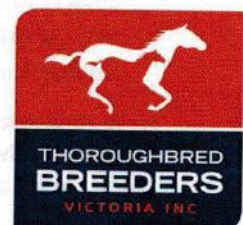

Rules & Regulations – Local Show

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships
2. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is open to boys and girls aged **10 years and under 15 years** on the day of the local Show/field day
3. All VAS affiliated Shows/field days are invited to hold the qualifying competitions. Show societies are encouraged to run one class at the local Show which includes girls and boys
4. The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account
5. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony
6. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband
7. A gear check may take place
8. **Please note: straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.**

Rules & Regulations – State Final

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships as one class for girls and boys
2. No entry fee will be charged but the entrant must fill out VAS Saddle Horse Championships entry form.
3. The VAS 'Good Hands Challenge Trophy' Competition shall be judged on the same basis as the qualifying competitions, but the Judge shall require: Five Finalists to execute a figure 8 at a canter, ride away from the Judge, return at a slow canter, stop at the Judge's signal and back
4. Equipment used must be as for the Qualifying Competition as specified above
5. The names of the winner will be engraved on the perpetual trophy
6. The winners of the 'Good Hands Challenge Trophy' will be eligible to compete in future years, subject to the age of the competitor
7. VAS Ltd may, at its discretion, vary the conditions governing the qualifying and Championship Competitions
